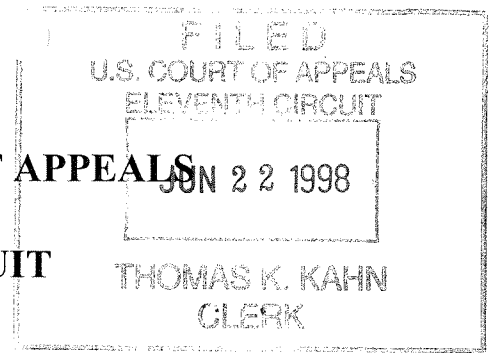




**GENERAL ORDER NO. 24**

Before HATCHETT, Chief Judge, TJOFLAT, ANDERSON, EDMONDSON, COX, BIRCH, DUBINA, BLACK, CARNES, BARKETT, HULL and MARCUS, Circuit Judges.

It is hereby ordered that 11th Cir. R. 30-1 is amended to add a new subsection (k) requiring counsel to include in record excerpts “the relevant parts of any document, such as a plea agreement, insurance policy, other contract, or ERISA plan, whose interpretation is central to the issues on appeal.” It is further ordered that this amended rule shall govern all appeals in which briefs are filed after the clerk gives notice to the parties of this rule.
