

In re: ELECTRONIC CASE FILES

In October 2011, the Court approved General Order 37 authorizing counsel voluntarily to file documents electronically in cases using the Court's Electronic Case Files ("ECF") system. Counsel's voluntary participation in the ECF system has worked well, and the Court now determines that electronic filing should be mandatory for all counsel.

Effective 1 April 2013, counsel are required to file documents electronically in appeals pending on that date and in appeals docketed in this Court on or after that date, following the procedures set out in the "Eleventh Circuit Guide to Electronic Filing" ("the Guide"). Reasonable exceptions to the requirement will be allowed, upon motion and a showing of good cause.

The Guide will be posted on the Court's website, www.ca11.uscourts.gov, and may be amended, as necessary, without prior notice.
