ORDER

_____ (“Complainant”) has filed this Complaint against United States Circuit Judge _____ (the “Subject Judge”), pursuant to Chapter 16 of Title 28 U.S.C. § 351(a) and the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings of the Judicial Conference of the United States (“JCDR”).

Background

A review of this Court’s files shows that since 2010, Complainant has not filed a Complaint of Judicial Misconduct or Disability in this Court and has not been involved in an appeal before this Court.

Complaint

In his Complaint of Judicial Misconduct or Disability, Complainant alleges that the Subject Judge “and the Judicial Conference Committee have violated [his] Statutory, Civil, Constitutional, and Human Rights by allowing Federal Judges to commit crimes and by refusing to address [his] Petitions for Review in violation of” 28 U.S.C § 331 “Judicial Conference of the United States.”

Discussion

Complainant provides no credible facts or evidence in support of his allegations that the Subject Judge engaged in misconduct.

The Complaint “is based on allegations lacking sufficient evidence to raise an inference that misconduct has occurred or that a disability exists,” JCDR 11(c)(1)(D). For that reason, pursuant to Chapter 16 of Title 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(iii) and Rule

11(c)(1)(D) of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings of the Judicial Conference of the United States, this Complaint is **DISMISSED**.
