## BY THE COURT:

In any appeal under the Sentencing Reform Act of 1984, Pub. L. No. 98-473, 98 Stat. 1987 (1984),

It is ORDERED that the defendant's presentence investigation report be transmitted to this court by the district court as a part of the record on appeal. If the presentence investigation report has been maintained under seal in the district court, the report shall be filed under seal in this Court. Upon written application to the clerk of this court, however, counsel for the defendant and for the government may examine the presentence investigation report or obtain a copy thereof, provided that counsel agrees not to duplicate the report or disclose the contents thereof to any person other than to the members of their staffs who have a need to know such contents and to the defendant.
