IN THE UNITED STATES COURT OF APPEALS FOR THE ELEVENTH CIRCUIT

Building Entry Requirements

- An individual SHALL NOT BE ALLOWED ACCESS to court facilities if the
 individual has tested positive for COVID-19 within the previous 5 days. After
 that 5-day period, an individual shall be allowed access if they are asymptomatic
 and (1) have tested negative for COVID-19, or (2) it has been 10 days since
 they initially tested positive.
- By entering court facilities, all individuals are self-certifying that they meet the requirements for doing so and that they will comply with posted signs.
- Any visitor or vendor denied access to a court facility will be asked to contact the appropriate court unit for further instructions.

Masking Inside Court Facilities

- Masking is optional in court facilities.
- Masked individuals may be asked to lower their masks briefly for identification purposes in compliance with safety and security requirements.
- The presiding judge of any court proceeding in any location may require the wearing of a mask during the proceeding.
