For the upcoming en banc rehearing in the above referenced case, the court desires for counsel to focus their briefs on the following issues:

Did the district court err in concluding that defendant Julian Garcon met the safety-valve-eligibility requirement set forth at 18 U.S.C. § 3553(f)(1)?

To answer this question, the parties should address, but are not limited to, the following issues:

- (1) Do we interpret the "and" in 18 U.S.C. § 3553(f)(1) in the disjunctive or conjunctive?
- (2) How do we interpret § 3553(f)(1)'s language referring to a "prior 3-point offense, as determined under the sentencing guidelines" and a "prior 2-point violent offense, as determined under the sentencing guidelines" when § 4A1.1 of the Sentencing Guidelines assigns criminal history points to a "prior sentence of imprisonment," not a "prior offense"?
