For purpose of the upcoming en banc rehearing in the above referenced case, the court desires for counsel to focus their briefs on the following question:

“Whether the district court’s judgment in this case should be affirmed, and why or why not that is so.”

Briefing Deadlines

The appellant's en banc brief is due **July 20, 2026**.

The appellee's en banc brief is due within 30 days after the service of the last appellant's brief. The appellant's en banc reply brief, if any, is due within 21 days after the service of the last appellee's brief. This is the only notice you will receive regarding the due date for briefs. **NO EXTENSIONS WILL BE GRANTED.** All parties must submit 10 paper copies of the brief to the clerk’s office the next business day. Counsel is not required to submit the additional copies of the previously filed briefs.

Form

Please see FRAP 32(a) and the corresponding circuit rules for information on the form of briefs and 11th Cir.R.40-9 for filing of an en banc amicus brief.

Brief Compliance Check Program

The Brief Compliance Check Program automatically checks briefs for compliance with the Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure and Eleventh Circuit Rules when they are filed electronically and identifies critical deficiencies that may need to be corrected. To check a brief before filing, select "Check PDF Document" under the Utilities tab on the main CM/ECF page, then select "Check pleading for Compliance with FRAP and Local Rules," enter the case number, select the type of brief being checked, and upload the brief.

Oral argument will be held in Atlanta in October 2026. Each side will have 20 minutes for argument.
