ORDER

Two individuals have filed a Complaint against a United States bankruptcy judge under the Judicial Conduct and Disability Act of 1980, 28 U.S.C. §§ 351–364, and the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings of the Judicial Conference of the United States.

Background

The record establishes that the Subject Judge was assigned to Complainants' Chapter 13 bankruptcy case, which is closed.

Complaint

Complainants take issue with various matters, but do not raise any specific allegations against the Subject Judge.

Discussion

The Complaint fails to present a basis for a finding of misconduct. Complainants provide no evidence to raise an inference that the Subject Judge engaged in misconduct. Judicial-Conduct Rule 11(c)(1)(D). For that reason, this Complaint is **DISMISSED**.
