ORDER

An individual has filed a Complaint against a United States district judge under the Judicial Conduct and Disability Act of 1980, 28 U.S.C. §§ 351–364, and the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings of the Judicial Conference of the United States.

## **Background**

The record establishes that Complainant filed a civil complaint against one defendant and a motion to proceed *in forma pauperis*. A magistrate judge issued a report recommending that Complainant's *in forma pauperis* motion be denied and his complaint be dismissed for failure to state a claim. Over Complainant's objections, the Subject Judge adopted the report and recommendation.

### Complaint

Complainant primarily discusses a district court case in another circuit, and he does not raise any specific allegations concerning the Subject Judge.

#### Discussion

The Complaint fails to present a basis for a finding of misconduct. Complainant provides no facts or evidence in support of a claim that the Subject Judge engaged in misconduct. Judicial-Conduct Rule 11(c)(1)(D). For that reason, this Complaint is **DISMISSED**.
